

St. Edmonds Academy Dance Guidelines/Permission Slip

1. The Diocese of Wilmington Code of Conduct and dress code will be enforced at all times.
2. In addition to this permission slip, "Form A: Annual Consent and Release" is required.
3. Any inappropriate conduct will result in losing the privilege of attending the dance. Fighting and/or bullying of any kind, and any misconduct of any kind, will not be tolerated. Parents/Guardians of any student involved in such behavior will be immediately contacted to pick up their child.
4. The dance is open to 6th – 8th graders. The doors open at 7:00 p.m. and the dance is over at 10:00 p.m. Drop off begins at 6:45 p.m. Children are not to be dropped off anywhere. Parents must drive to the indicated entrance at St. Edmonds Academy to drop off their child. When the dance is over, parents must follow the pick-up protocol.
5. Once admitted, no students may leave the building before the end of the dance without a parent or guardian escort.
6. Refreshments and snacks will be available at the dance for purchase (water, pretzels, candy).
7. This permission slip, the signed consent form, \$10 cash, and a donation of new socks are required to enter the dance.
8. Clothing should be appropriate. This prohibits short shorts, tank tops, baggy pants, bikinis, and any reference or advertisements of inappropriate products.
